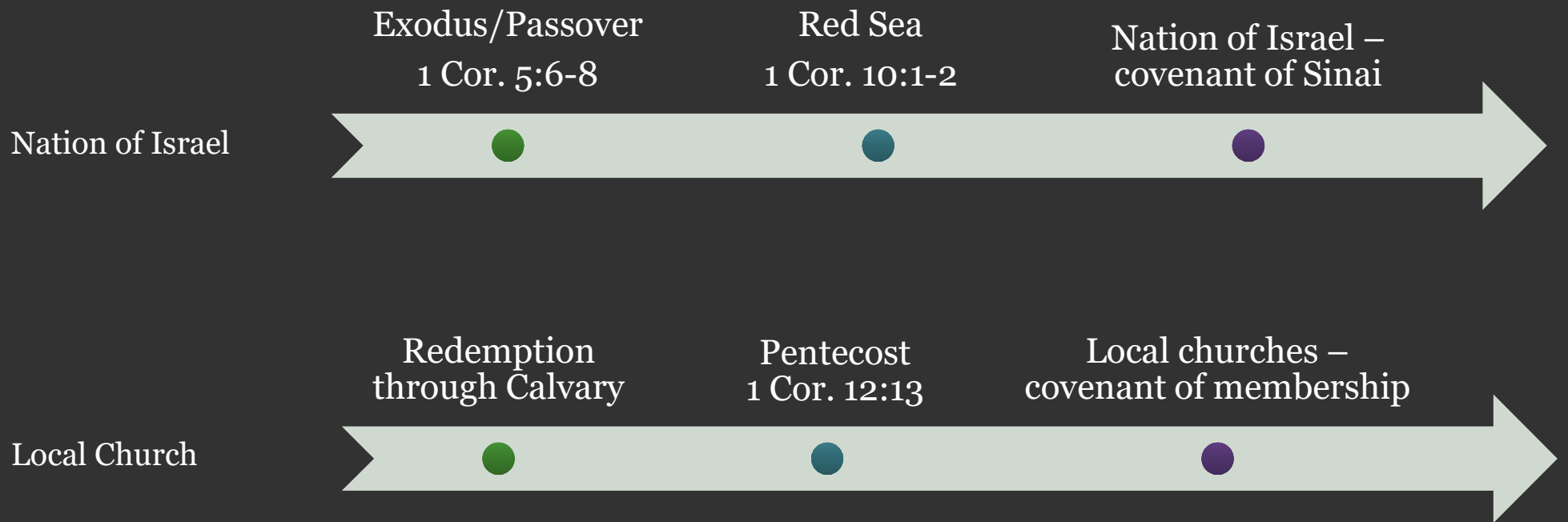
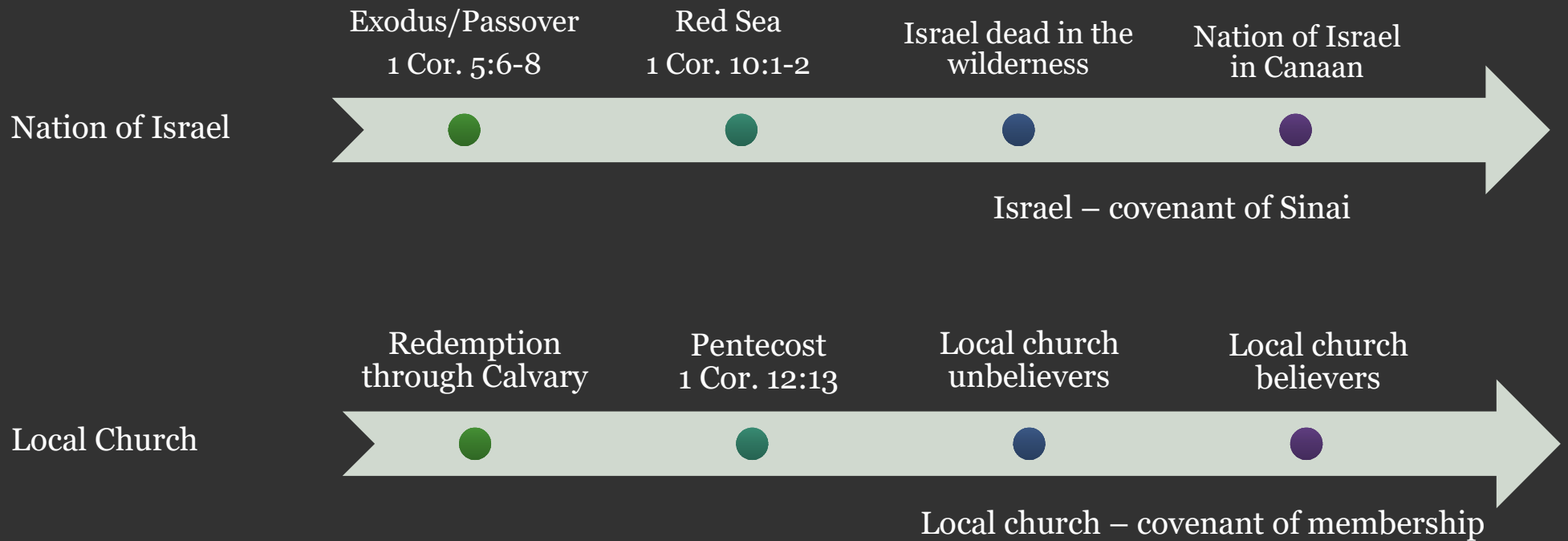

Israel in Canaan & Local church believers

- ❑ They hear God's voice and are called *brothers* (v. 7, 12).
- ❑ They do not harden their hearts (v. 8).
- ❑ They do not provoke or test God (v. 9).
- ❑ They do not make God angry (v. 10).
- ❑ They do not go astray in their hearts (v. 10).
- ❑ They know God's ways (v. 10).
- ❑ They are not under God's wrath (v. 11).
- ❑ They are not forbidden salvation by faith-rest (v. 11).
- ❑ They watch for unbelief in the assembly through encouragement against the deceitfulness of sin and through holding fast to their own confidence and faith (vv. 12).
- ❑ They do not disobey and disbelieve (vv. 18-19; 4:3).

Israel in wilderness & Local church unbelievers
