Luke 18:15-27

“The things which are impossible with men are possible with God.”



“Who then can be saved?”

- What prompts the question? (Luke 18:18-26).
- The large size of a camel, and the small size of a needle.
 - Riches cause this impossible difficulty (Luke 18:24-25).
 - Show business causes this impossible difficulty (2 Tim. 4:3-4).
 - Rock music causes this impossible difficulty (Ps. 40:1-3).
 - Other?



Who then can be saved?

- What is the answer to the question? (Luke 18:27).
- “The things which are impossible with men are possible with God.”
 - Dr. Gamaliel: “And now I say unto you, Refrain from these men, and let them alone: for if this counsel or this work be of men, it will come to nought: But if it be of God, ye cannot overthrow it; lest haply ye be found even to fight against God” (Acts 5:38-39).
 - Revival is possible, but only for God (Luke 18:15-17).
